



Risk Assessment - Mentrau Iaith

First Aid Personnel	Required Yes / No	Numbers Needed
First aid at work (3 day)	No	0
Emergency First aid at work (1 day)	Yes	One to cover the floor at all times (From numbers provided 2/3 should be sufficient)
Pediatric First Aid (2 day)	Yes	One to cover the floor at all times.
Bespoke Pediatric (3 hour)	Yes	2/3 to assist the main pediatric first aider who has done the 2 day pediatric first aid course.

AED	Yes If available but no legislation covers this, this is not mandatory.	1
Traveling first aid kit	No Unless taking children off site	0

This environment is very low risk therefore stereotypical injuries will be mild bleeding, faints and one offs such as choking. If there are office workers that have got history of heart problems, diabetes or asthma then it would be advisable for a member of staff to go on the 3 day first aid at work.

We would advise in any childcare setting for a member of staff to have completed a 2 day paediatric first aid course. We do advise all staff to carry out this training but realise this is not possible in all settings therefore we would advise a small group to do a bespoke first aid course tailored to paediatrics. Please note that if Millies Law comes into place in Wales this may change. Trystan will advise on this.
